

# New Kingdom Trailriders Scholarship Requirements

New Kingdom Trailriders (NKT) services the greater Quad City area and surrounding communities by empowering children, adults, and military veterans facing physical, mental, social and emotional challenges to create active healthier, and more fulfilling lives through equine-assisted activities.

NKT does everything possible to provide lessons to all individuals in need, including helping to find resources for payment as well as providing scholarships to qualifying participants.

For the 2025 Riding Season NKT will award roughly twelve (12) scholarships per riding session to individuals who have provided the proper completed paperwork and have proven financial need. Six (6) of those scholarships will be awarded directly to individuals who apply by the session one due date and are applying for all six sessions. The other six (6) scholarships will be awarded to individuals on a session-by-session basis.

To apply for a scholarship with New Kingdom Trailriders the following must be completed and returned to NKT **no later than the application due date listed below for each session**.

All Rider Paperwork must be completed and turned in at the same time or before the Rider Scholarship Packet. Incomplete rider paperwork will result in an incomplete scholarship application.

Scholarship applications **MUST BE** turned in by the below date to be considered. Any application received after the required due date will not be accepted for the session applied for. However, scholarship packets may be carried over to the following session in the same riding year.

If a hand drawn picture showcases you or your rider's abilities better than written words, a drawing may be included with the paragraph written by the parent/guardian.

Full Year Scholarship recipient requirements:

Riders who receive a full year scholarship are still responsible for paying a fee of \$25 (group lessons) or \$30 (private lessons) for each session. All fees must be paid before the riders first lesson or they will not be considered for further scholarships in the 2025 riding season

Upon completion of each session riders are required to submit a paragraph\* with a photo\*, explaining how this scholarship has positively impacted you or your rider's life. If a hand drawn picture showcases you or your rider's abilities better than written words, a drawing may be included with the paragraph written by the parent/guardian.
